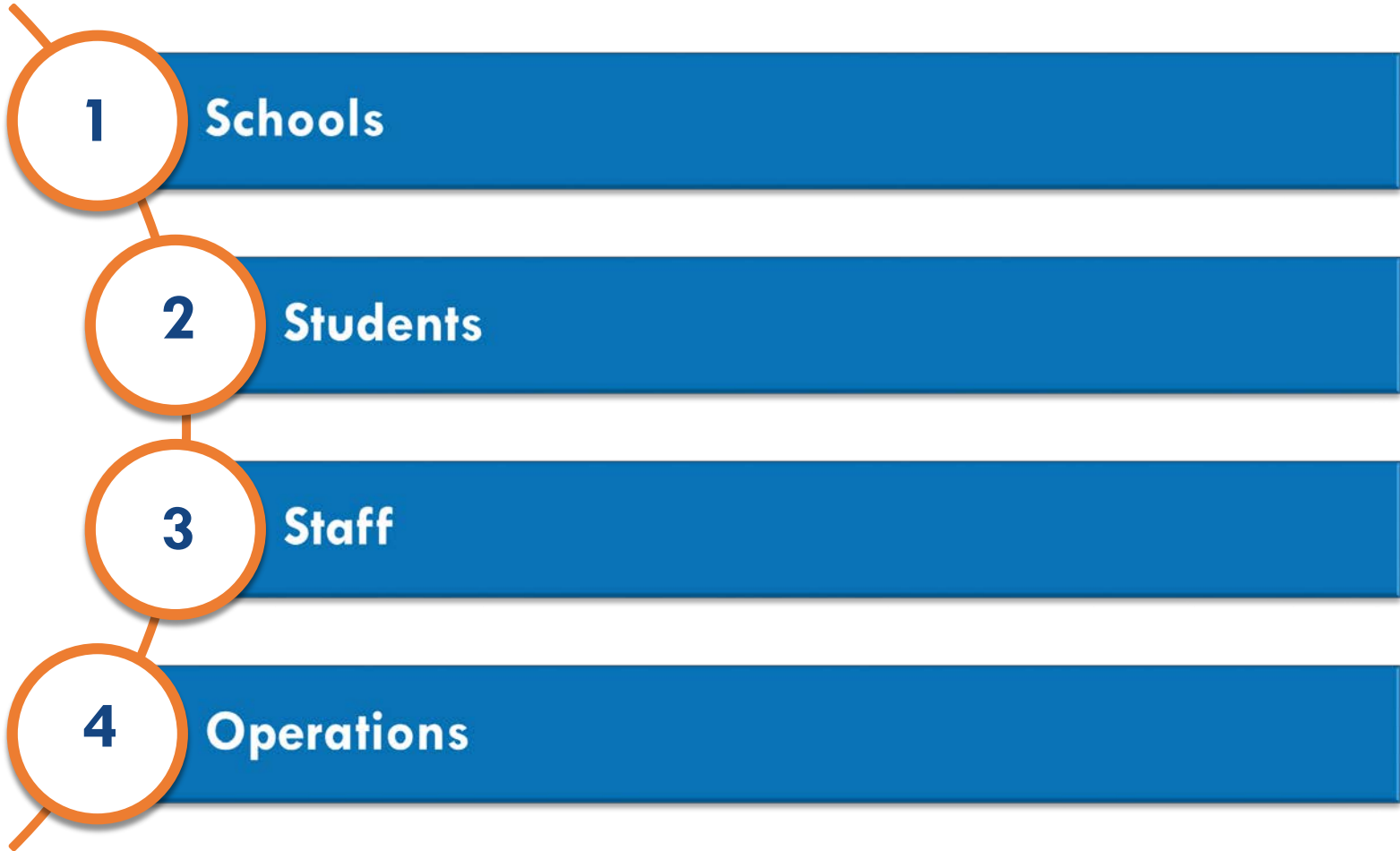

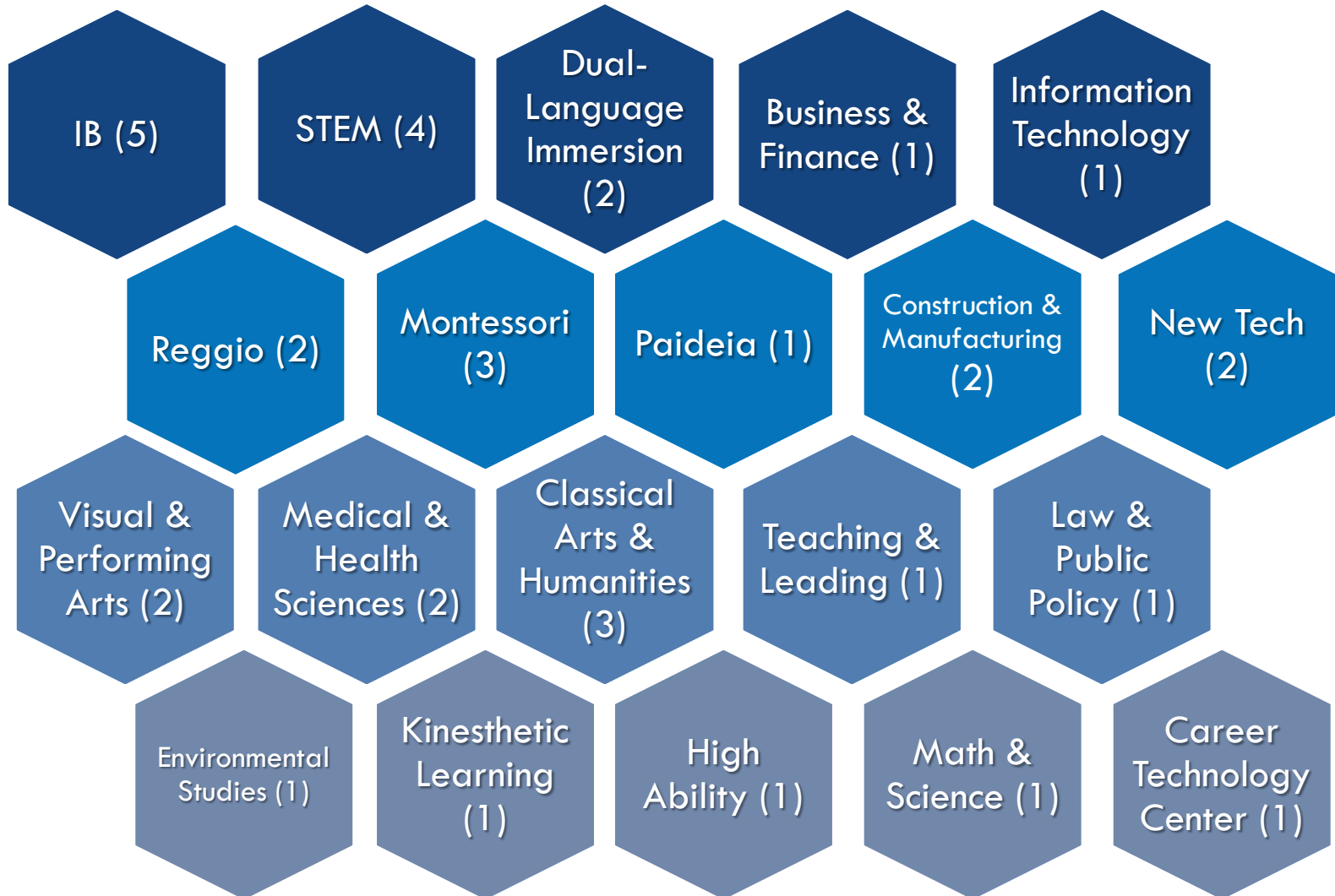

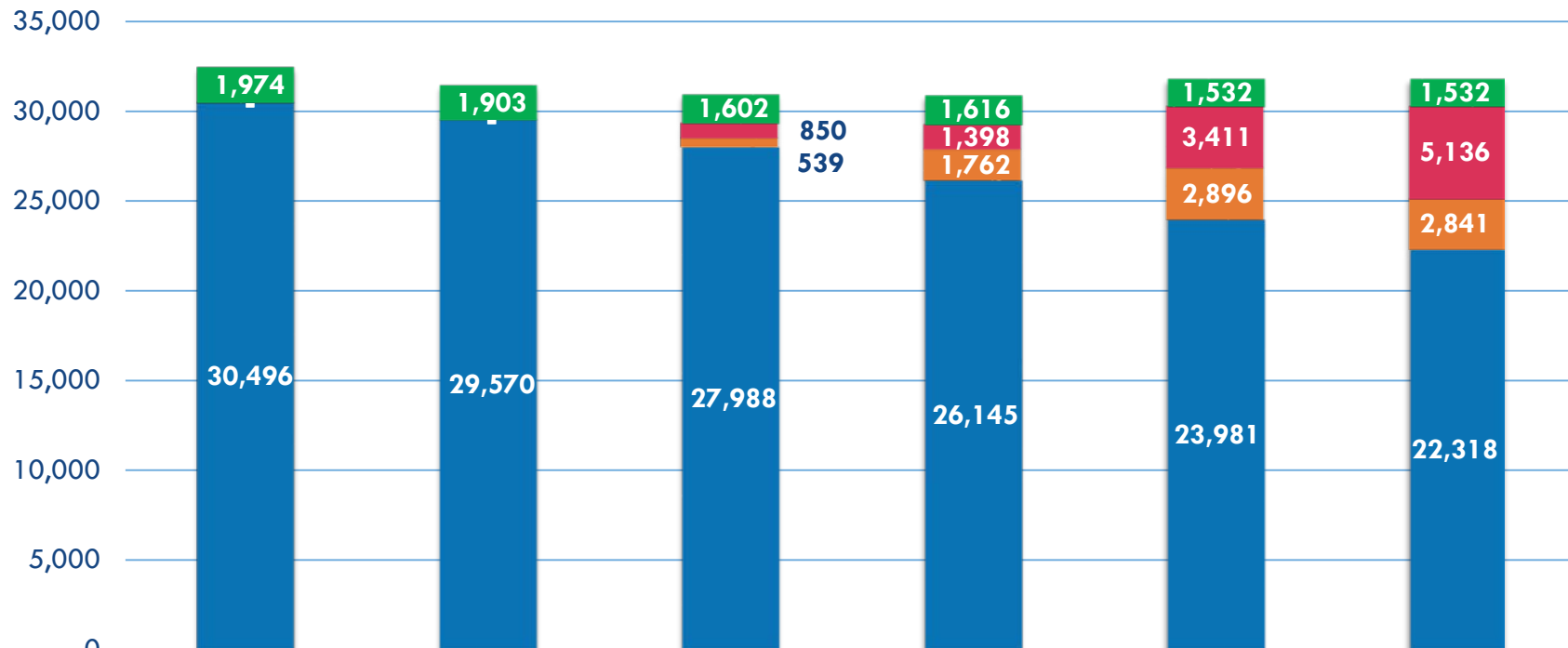

IPS enrollment is on an upward trend

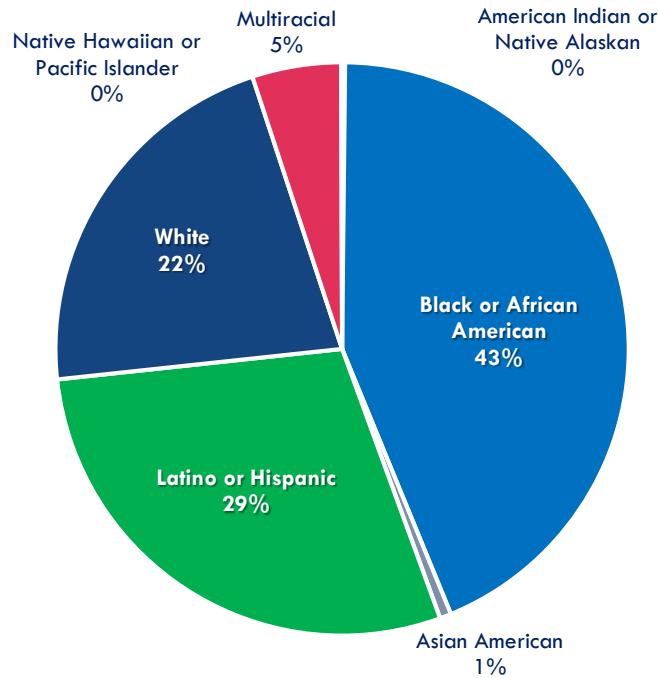
Enrollment Comparison SY 2010–11 to SY 2018–19 (Projected)

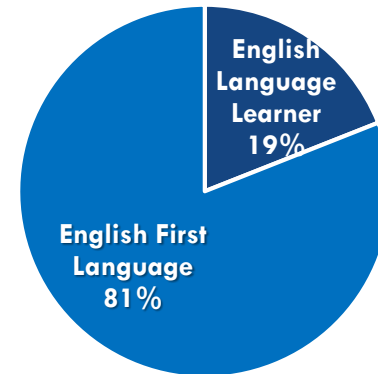

Ethnicity



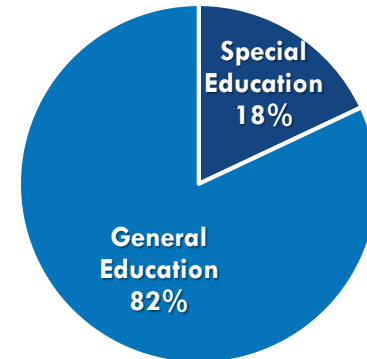

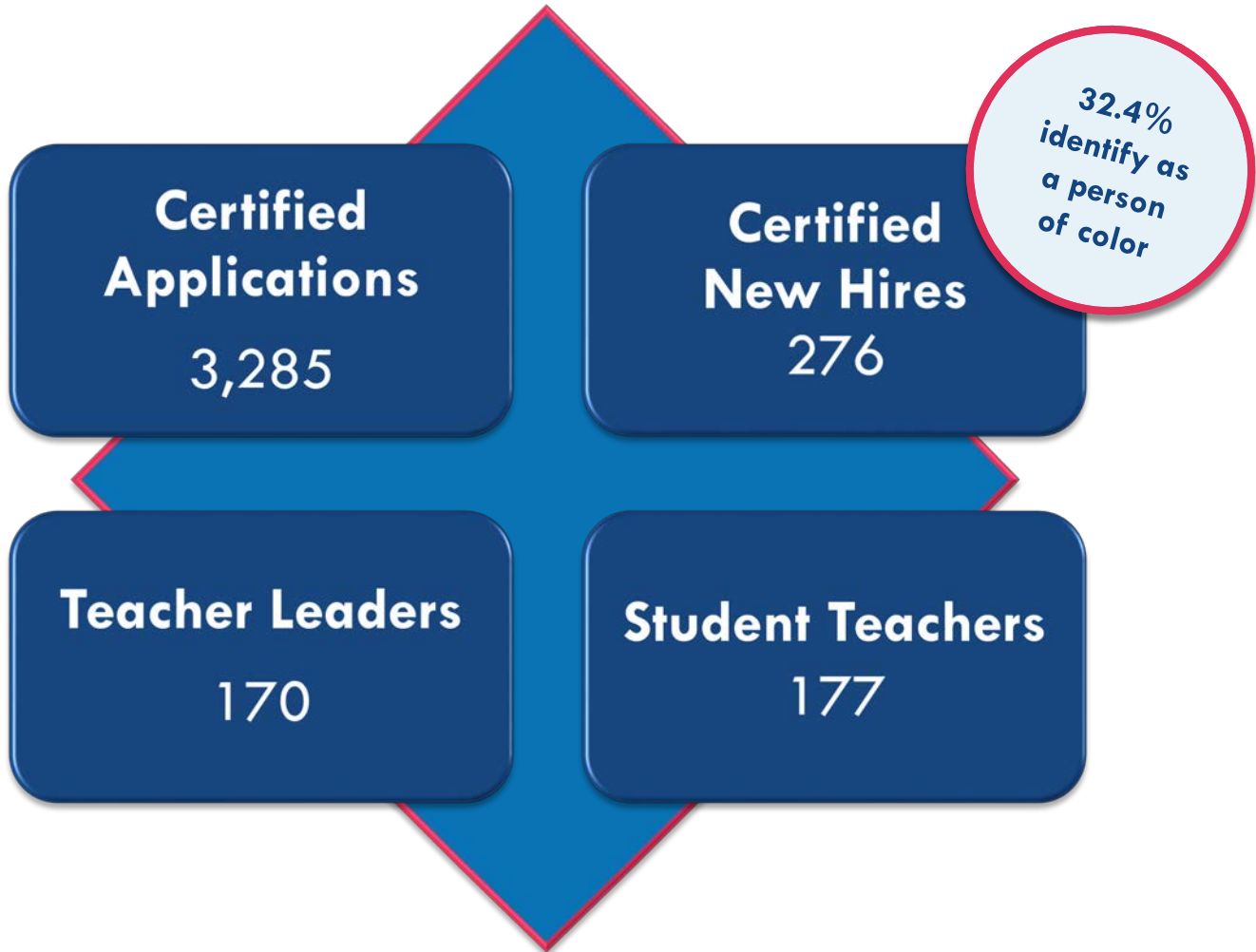
